#### LOST DOG WASH TO TALIESIN OVERLOOK


Lost Dog Wash Trailhead (12601 N. 124th St., Scottsdale) **Length:** 4.8 mi / 7.7 km (round trip) **Rating:** Moderate This trail runs parallel to verdant Lost Dog Wash and offers a distant glimpse of Frank Lloyd Wright's Taliesin West.

#### PINNACLE PEAK SUMMIT

Pinnacle Peak Park (26802 N. 102nd Way, Scottsdale) **Length:** 3.5 mi / 5.6 km (round trip) **Rating:** Moderate This wide, smooth trail switchbacks to the top of the iconic Pinnacle Peak in North Scottsdale.

#### MARCUS LANDSLIDE INTERPRETIVE TRAIL

Tom's Thumb Trailhead (23015 N. 128th St., Scottsdale) Length: 3.0 mi / 4.8 km (round trip) Rating: Moderately Difficult This beautiful trail has interpretive signs explaining the origin of the Marcus Landslide, one of the largest in Arizona.

Try these easy hikes in Scottsdale's McDowell Sonoran Preserve for some gentle adventures. Just remember, easy doesn't mean dull. These also are some of the best Scottsdale hikes you'll find.

Family is not only the name, but also the theme of this peaceful trail at the edge of Lost Dog Wash. Interpretive signs along the route explore family relationships of the plants and animals that live in this desert community.

Only 0.5 miles long, the Kovach Family Nature Trail is a double loop laid out in the shape of a scraggly figure-8 at the Lost Dog Wash Trailhead. Named for a family that championed Scottsdale's McDowell Sonoran Preserve since its earliest days, the trail meanders among a fine assortment of cactus. Stately saguaros, burly barrels and adorable but ruthless teddy bear chollas rub spiny elbows with ocotillo, brittlebush and triangle-leaf bursage—all identified by helpful signs. The trail makes a sly and scenic classroom.

Best of all, everyone is welcome. With a level grade and firm surface, the Kovach Trail is ADA accessible, suitable for wheelchairs, walkers and strollers. Everyone can enjoy the picturesque desert setting beneath a broad sky, making this trail perfect for you and your family.



1 SUNSCREEN: Sunscreen is a necessity no matter what time of year you visit! 2 WHISTLE: If you need assistance, the sound of a whistle carries farther than your voice. 3 WATER: Carry more than you think you'll need for everyone in your party, including pets. Bring at least 1 quart per person for short hikes and at least 1 gallon per person for longer hikes. 4 TRAIL MAP: Maps of Scottsdale's McDowell Sonoran Preserve can be downloaded at scottsdaleaz.gov/preserve. **5 CELL PHONE:** A fully charged cell phone is the best item to have in the event of an emergency. 6 SNACKS: Refuel with snacks like nuts, dried fruit, jerky or energy bars. 7 COMB: A fine-tooth comb comes in handy for flicking away cholla cactus buds that can attach to shoes, skin or clothes if you brush against them.

#### FRAESFIELD LOOP HIKE (WHISKEY BOTTLE -TURPENTINE-BLACK HILL)

Combine three trail segments to weave through a lush basin, shaggy with vegetation and bright with spring wildflowers. It also highlights mountain views, both near and far. From the Fraesfield Trailhead, start on Whiskey Bottle Trail. It rambles for 1.6 miles. making an easy climb along the east. flank of Fraesfield Mountain. From this elevated perch you'll see a valley floor veined by arroyos. Water collects in low-lying areas, accounting for the density of desert scrub providing a buffet of browse for deer and javelina.

Hang a right on the Turpentine Trail as it crosses shallow washes, angling toward the rocky hump of Granite Mountain. Fine vertical notes adorn the landscape where saguaros mingle with tall yucca flower spikes, covered in white blooms like butterfly chandeliers. Desert marigold and globemallow add more splashes of spring color. Then in late summer the aromatic turpentine bush is consumed by a cloud of yellow flowers. Anyone who claims the Sonoran Desert is drab hasn't spent much time walking around it.

After 1.3 miles on Turpentine, make a final right on Black Hill Trail as it angles through the scrub back to the trailhead. Savor the views of a horizon capped by the Four Peaks and the Superstition Mountains. The total for the loop is 4.6 miles.

#### **BROWN'S RANCH LOOP** (BROWN'S RANCH ROAD -**UPPER RANCH TRAIL)**

There's a weird siren song to Brown's Mountain that pulls hikers into its




orbit. Don't fight the urge; just enjoy the journey. The distinctive formation with the almost-flat-yet-slightlyjaunty top is a centerpiece of the northern section of the McDowell Sonoran Preserve. Combine two very different trails to understand it better.

From Brown's Ranch Trailhead, start on Brown's Ranch Road, a main artery that's wide, smooth and effortless, like hiking the moving sidewalk at the airport. As you begin to wrap around it, the mountain offers intriguing new looks. You'll pass Brown's Mountain Trail (the summit climb) in 0.6 miles, but save that challenge for another day. As the path narrows, vegetation crowds in so it feels like you're burrowing through a tunnel of mesquite, creosote and

soaptree yucca. Remnants of the old ranch can be seen with a short stroll down the Corral Trail.

At the Upper Ranch Trail, turn left, climbing partway up the slope for views across the preserve. The trail swings south, navigating an elegant saguaro forest as it squeezes between Brown's Mountain and boulder-crusted Cone Mountain. A series of undulating hills keeps things interesting while also providing a modest workout. You'll traverse lots of little ups and downs, but the scenery is so exquisite it's worth the effort. Consider this an easy hike but with a plot twist. The Upper Ranch Trail finally rejoins Brown's Ranch Road a stone's throw from the trailhead for a 4-mile loop.





cottsdale is renowned for its stunning desert landscapes, luxurious resorts, foodie culture and vibrant nightlife. But bodies of water? Not exactly. However, just a short drive from the city center, adventure seekers will find an unexpectedly different type of tranquility, gliding across serene lakes and rivers.

Paddling, whether seated in a kayak or atop a stand-up paddleboard (SUP), is a fantastic way to both unwind and exercise, connect with nature and savor the beauty surrounding Scottsdale. Whether you're an avid paddler or a novice, these five destinations offer something for everyone.

### Number One SAGUARO LAKE

Just 30 minutes northeast of Scottsdale, Saguaro Lake offers year-round paddling amid the rugged Tonto National Forest. Colorful desert cliffs and towering saguaro cacti surround the lake, creating a picturesque backdrop for your adventure (especially at sunrise and sunset).

Saguaro Lake is especially popular for paddle camping and fishing. Exactly what it sounds like, you can fish from your kayak or SUP, or load your gear up and camp along the lake. Riverbound Sports and other local outfitters provide rentals with on-site delivery, and REI's two Phoenix-area stores offer guided adventures for all experience levels.

### Number Two BARTLETT LAKE

Bartlett Lake is a hidden gem for paddlers seeking a quieter, less crowded experience. With minimal boat traffic and fewer visitors in general, it's a tranquil spot for kayaking or paddleboarding near Scottsdale.

About an hour north of Scottsdale and surrounded by the Tonto National Forest, the lake is clear and pristine, complemented by gorgeous desert scenery. Another bonus that comes with fewer crowds is frequent wildlife sightings. Keep your eyes open for javelinas, wild burros, eagles and coyotes! Bring your own kayaks or SUPs, or rent on-site at the Bartlett Lake Marina. There also is a variety of classes. including Full Moon Night Paddles and SUP Yoga. Dogs also are welcome.





### Number Three LOWER SALT RIVER

If a river is more your speed (literally!), head east for paddleboarding the Salt River (pictured above). Located a few miles downriver from Saguaro Lake in the heart of the Sonoran Desert are several sections ideal for paddling. You'll find both calm sections for leisurely floating and thrilling rapids for more experienced adventurers.

In particular, many people put in at the Phon D. Sutton Recreation Area or Coon Bluff, then paddle down to the Granite Reef Dam. It's important to note that if you're not going out with a guide, you'll need to set up a vehicle shuttle to have cars at each end. Also, while you can technically paddle the Salt year-round, it's heavily dependent on streamflow. You can monitor this yourself on SRP's website; 500 to 1,500 cfs (cubic feet per second) is ideal.

One last thing: Summer on the Salt River means tubing season. Get an early start to avoid the crowds. You have a better chance of seeing the iconic wild horses then, too!

### **Number Four CANYON LAKE**

About 45 minutes east, Canyon Lake is one of the most popular places to go paddleboarding near Scottsdale. As its name suggests, steep canyon walls mesmerize paddlers, while turquoise waters provide a natural oasis in the desert.


With its calm waters and several coves where motorboats are prohibited, Canyon Lake seems to cater specifically to paddlers. The eastern side of the lake is generally even calmer, with no waves to contend with. Vendors also rent kayaks and SUPs at the Canyon Lake Marina, so you can just show up and explore the lake.

### Number Five TEMPE TOWN LAKE

For a quick, convenient place to go kayaking or paddleboarding near Scottsdale, head to Tempe Town Lake. Sure, you'll trade unobstructed views for an urban landscape, but you truly can't beat the convenience.

The 2-mile-long inlet was created specifically as a training facility for local rowing and sailing teams (that's rightsailing in Arizona!), so the conditions are ideal for paddling. Several local outfitters organize paddling meetups, offer lessons, and rent kayaks and SUPs (some even deliver to the lake).

In addition to these five places to enjoy kayaking and paddleboarding near Scottsdale, you'll find many others if you venture a bit farther out. Lake Pleasant is just 45 minutes northwest, while Watson Lake in Prescott and the stretch of the Verde River near Clarkdale are considered some of the best places to paddle in the entire state.



Arizona is rugged and gorgeous and historic and weird and funny and utterly magnificent. It's full of surprises, not what most people expect at all. That's why I wrote my book, Awesome Arizona: 200 Amazing Facts about the Grand Canyon State.

I wanted to capture the essence of Arizona, from its wild and woolly past to its breathtaking scenery to its incredible diversity of cultures and terrain. The book is part love letter, part encyclopedia.

So, if you're looking for memorable things to do in Arizona with some incredible day trips from Scottsdale, I've got you covered. Here are five random facts from the book that also translate to top Arizona attractions.



ARIZONA IS THE ONLY STATE THAT

At the Grand Canyon, nothing prepares you for the size or scale or intensity of colors. Terraces of temples and castles spill endlessly downward into ancient depths. It feels like you're peeking at God's diary. Hike the Rim Trail, a mostly paved path that stretches for 13 miles along the edge of the abyss, so the views are relentless. Return via one of the free shuttle buses that are constantly in motion.

Browse among the historic buildings of Grand Canyon Village. Dine at historic El Tovar Hotel. The Desert View Watchtower, a 70-foot stone tower designed by architect Mary Colter, stands guard at the eastern edge of the national park. nps.gov/grca



THE ONLY MCDONALD'S IN THE WORLD FOUND IN SEDONA.

Sedona has its own style in every way, from tasteful fast-food establishments to a stunning skyline of red-rock mesas, buttes and columns. Jeep tours are a signature Sedona experience amid such impossible beauty. Each company offers signature rides ranging from gentle excursions to boulder-climbing thrillfests.

Tlaquepaque Arts & Crafts Village houses a collection of galleries and restaurants in a setting reminiscent of a Mexican hamlet, with cobblestone walkways and shady courtyards. The Chapel of the Holy Cross, an architectural wonder rising from the red rocks, offers a place for sweeping views and quiet contemplation. visitsedona.com



In the heart of this forested expanse, Flagstaff nestles at the base of Arizona's tallest mountains. Skiers carve up Snowbowl's slopes in winter. Then in summer and fall, the scenic Arizona Gondola glides up to the mountaintop, offering incredible panoramas.

Flagstaff features a bustling downtown filled with great restaurants, bars and breweries sprawled along Historic Route 66. Take a tour of Lowell Observatory, where Pluto was discovered. Or step back in time with a visit to Walnut Canyon National Monument, where ancient Sinagua cliff dwellings are secreted away in a steep-walled gorge. flagstaffarizona.org



### THE WORLD'S OLDEST RODEO STILL BUCKS UP A STORM IN PRESCOTT.

A stately courthouse amid a tree-shaded plaza anchors one of the state's loveliest downtowns. Take a walking tour and belly up to the bar at The Palace, where Wyatt Earp and Doc Holliday once drank.



For architecture and mid-century aesthetic lovers alike, **Frank Lloyd Wright's Taliesin West** is a must-see. Designated an official UNESCO World Heritage Site, Taliesin West is an illustrious example of shape and form built immaculately into its surrounding desert frame. Wright himself made Taliesin his winter home, and his love and respect for the Sonoran landscape show in every detail.

Swordfish burritos. Whole pig. Brunch tasting menus. An exciting wave of new restaurants adds punch to a food scene that has been heating up for a few years. Here's where to eat your next great meal in Scottsdale.



### **COURSE**

To Arizona food insiders, Chef Cory Oppold has been a must-follow for his playful, high-end tasting menus. His latest venture is Course: five- and 10course dinners in an intimate space, meals that give you a tour of unique culinary imagination. Though some plates look like modern art, Oppold manages to keep his food fun and relatable. Focaccia comes with "grilled cheese butter." A "peach Wellington" replaces the old-school beef original. Restaurants in this mold often miss, but Oppold doesn't. On Sundays, try his brunch tasting menu.

### ÉLEPHANTE

Confession: This eatery hasn't opened yet. But the ambitious coastal Italian restaurant from LA will be coming to Scottsdale Fashion Square in 2024. What to expect? An elevated evolution of the Santa Monica original. An indooroutdoor dining experience with, its announcement says, "the ambience of a jungle oasis, characterized by towering cacti, lush florals, natural travertine floors and bespoke furniture." Woodfired pizzas, fresh pastas, grilled meat and seafood, and family-style offerings will anchor the menu. There will be a wine selection with north of 1,200 labels. Keep your eyes on this high-flying opening.





### **PESCADA**

You'll find one of Scottsdale's great new restaurant patios at Pescada, a whitetablecloth Western European eatery by Chef Sheila Bryson. Food is more formal and can lean creative, with seafood classics like fritto misto and inspired pastas like squid-ink pici leading the way. The cocktail program at Pescada punches above its weight. A nice selection of thoughtful, herbaceous gin-and-tonics sidekick a happy-hour menu of snacks like a trio of house breads and bacalao croquettes. Enjoy them on the porch if vou can.



### **ARBOLEDA**

Cavernous, sleek and spiritually anchored by the olive tree in the dining room, this Scottsdale Quarter restaurant cooks dishes inspired by Mediterranean coasts. The menu is pretty much a greatest-hits list of favorites from Portugal to Israel: seafood pastas, lamb meatballs, peri peri chicken, and so on. The dishes from Spain go especially hard, like a luscious, crispskinned Iberico pork with frybread and a paella-of-the-day for two. For maximum enjoyment, start at the bar with red sangria.

### **PICCOLO VIRTÙ**

Located in the heart of Old Town, the third inventive Italian restaurant by Chef Gio Osso might be his most eccentric. Dishes move beyond tradition. His carbonara pasta uses grano arso, a specialty flour milled from burnt wheat. His sea bass sports foam with licorice hints. Raw fish (crudo) starters are a menu section worth exploring deeply. These plates are small but mighty, looping in fresh, out-of-thebox flavors. A family-style menu section boasts feasts like a giant Porterhouse, a whole rack of lamb and an 8- to 10-pound suckling pig.





### **CHULA SEAFOOD GRAYHAWK**

This super-chill seafood spot catches some of its own fish in the Pacific Ocean waters near San Diego, sourcing the rest through fishing connections. Chula serves fish raw, fried and grilled. It's all dockside fresh, from generous Korean-inspired poke bowls to cioppino piled high with fried calamari and shellfish. Watch Chula's Instagram for big, ambitious specials. The daily IYKYK order here, though, is harpoon-caught swordfish tucked into a burrito with fries. Yup, that swordfish is caught from Chula's very own boat.

oney is a natural ingredient that has been prized for centuries, not only for its sweetness, but also for its health benefits that include antioxidant properties and immune support. Arizona's diverse landscape influences flavors such as mesquite, wildflower, orange blossom, acacia and desert blue clover, and in cocktails, it serves as a versatile alternative to processed sugar. Here are some creative ways Scottsdale's talented bartenders are incorporating honey into their cocktails.

"TELL YOUR FRIENDS"

The House Brasserie

At this charming Old Town restaurant occupying a historic home built in 1939, Beverage Director Richard Allison helms a stellar cocktail program. For "Tell Your Friends," he uses local mesquite honey, harvested from the blossoms of the mesquite tree, and infuses it with turmeric before blending it with a split base of tequila and mezcal, passion fruit liqueur and lime juice. "It complements the different seasons of Arizona," says Allison. "The mesquite flavors of the honey enhance the smoky agave notes of tequila and mezcal, and the passion fruit balances the cocktail out and brightens it up."

### "ZOMBIE"

### Toro at Fairmont Scottsdale Princess

"Since we have so many out-of-state visitors, we wanted to do a Southwest variation with local ingredients," explains

Senior Beverage Manager John Wilhelm, who accents this tiki classic with prickly pear purée and mesquite honey. Combined with three different styles of rum – Jamaican, Barbados and a spiced rum – along with falernum, grapefruit juice, lime juice and Angostura bitters, the honey provides a mellow sweetness that complements the vibrant tropical flavors. "It has a different sweetness and viscosity and just combines so well with the other ingredients," Wilhelm notes.

### "VERSACE ON THE FLOOR"

### The Americano

"Aside from helping with your immune system, honey is more complex and has more depth and flavor than a simple syrup," says bar lead Holly Achs. For this best-selling cocktail at celebrity chef Scott Conant's restaurant, vodka is infused with Serrano peppers and Fresno chiles and shaken up with mesquite honey, lime juice and Sonoran Olive Oil Company's coconut white balsamic vinegar before being topped with a cap of velvety egg white whipped with basil and olive oil. "It has lots of layers of flavors and complexity," notes Achs, "and using honey adds earthiness and a bit more body to the drink."

### "CITRONETTE"

### Course

An artful blend of gin, orange blossom honey, yellow chartreuse, and fresh grapefruit and mandarin juices, the Citronette was created to evoke an oceanside vacation, says General Manager Nicholas Padua, who curates the beverage program. Crowning the libation is a stunning salt and kombu foam. "We use Sheringham Seaside Gin, which has a really fresh zing of citrus but is also made with kelp," says Padua. "The bubbles on top of the drink have sea salt and kombu seaweed for savoriness and salinity, so it's like you're coming up from the ocean and drinking a refreshing citrus cocktail. I love honey as a sweetener, and it also naturally has umami characteristics that combine so well with the seaweed in the gin and the foam."

### "HONEY HARVEST SOUR" Arboleda

Head bartender Richie Moe celebrates honey three ways in this delicious libation by mixing London dry gin with orange blossom honey syrup and a sweet-andsour honey oleo saccharum (a syrup made by extracting the oils from citrus peels with granulated honey crystals), before garnishing with bee pollen. "I absolutely love honey and gin," says Moe. "It's a classic pairing." To enhance this combination. he uses WorldClass Clementine Earl Grey tea blended with orange blossom, bergamot and clementine before shaking with egg white and decorating with a tangy Aleppo chile and red wine vinegar shrub, Aleppo chile flakes and bee pollen. "Using honey three ways adds a lot of depth and complexity," he notes.
