




SCOTTSDALE FASHION SQUARE

KIERLAND COMMONS



This central-Scottsdale resort recently completed a \$40 million property-wide renovation that included refurbishing all guestrooms and public spaces, including Luna Spa. On the heels of a \$115 million property-wide renovation, the Hyatt Regency Scottsdale Resort & Spa was unveiled in October 2024 as Arizona's first Grand Hyatt property. The resort's reimagined guestrooms and suites offer décor that celebrates the interplay of light, water and desert botanicals while offering breathtaking McDowell Mountain vistas. DINE



UCHI SCOTTSDALE

Founded by award-winning chef Tyson Cole, Uchi, meaning "house" in Japanese, extends the intimacy of the sushi bar throughout the entire restaurant. The one-of-a-kind menu features non-traditional Japanese cuisine, signature tastings, sushi and a seasonal omakase. Look forward to delights like Wagyu Carpaccio with fried jalapeño, masu crudo (ocean trout, oat milk tom kha and Japanese sweet potato) and craft cocktails like the Shiso Mojito.



ONE HANDSOME BASTARD DISTILLERY & GRILL

One Handsome Bastard makes award-winning vodka and gin. Guests can taste five different flavors of vodka along with the distillery's famous blood orange gin. The cocktail menu offers great combinations of house-made spirits along with bar favorites, beer and wine. Upscale bar food is offered, but the ½-pound burgers, made from ground chuck seasoned to perfection, take first prize.



BEGINNER'S LUCK

This new concept from local chef Bernie Kantak dishes up elevated comfort food favorites in the heart of Old Town. The brunch, midday and dinner menus include delights like the Lucky 7 Cereal Bowl (chia pudding, blue corn grits, berries and coconut-pecan granola), Kantak's Original Chopped Salad, and the coffee-charred Steak Fritz - 12 ounces of prime certified angus NY strip with Hungarian goat horn chile butter, pomme "fritz" and paprikash sour cream.



THE FRYBREAD LOUNGE

Sample authentic flavors of the Southwest at The Frybread Lounge, Old Town's first and only Indigenous-owned restaurant. Chef Darryl Montana, a member of the Tohono O'odham Community, offers an elevated menu of appetizers and entrées inspired by local Indigenous communities. Specialties include classic frybread (both sweet and savory options), bison asada tacos, Three Sisters Salad and sweet treats like a caramel sunflower tart.






WALK N ABOUT SCOTTSDALE

Scottsdale's lush Sonoran Desert setting and 330 days of annual sunshine make any day a great day for outdoor exploration and adventure. Whether you're looking for a laid-back guided excursion or something a little - or a lot - more thrilling, Scottsdale has you covered with these options for exploring our sun-drenched desert landscape.



FLY HIGH

In a landscape as panoramic as the Sonoran Desert, there's no better way to soak it all in than from the gondola of a hot air balloon. Drift along with the breeze as your pilot guides you high into the air for expansive scenic views or dips close to the ground for a glimpse of wildlife. Your flight concludes with a champagne toast amid the towering saguaros.




STROLL THE GARDEN

If you're looking for a more urban adventure, the Desert Botanical Garden offers five paved thematic trails and more than 50,000 desert plants to explore. You'll see everything from massive saguaro cacti and alluring succulents to colorful wildflowers and lacy shade trees. Plan to enjoy lunch or dinner at the Garden's on-site restaurant. Gertrude's.



A Jeep or Hummer tour with an experienced guide is a great way to learn about the Sonoran Desert's fascinating history, geology and delicate ecosystem. Want to kick up the adventure quotient? Get behind the wheel of your own Tomcar, ATV or UTV for an exhilarating ride down rugged desert trails.



Unleash your inner cowpoke on a guided horseback ride. From your vantage point tall in the saddle, you'll enjoy stunning Sonoran Desert views as you ride through rolling mountain foothills and verdant desert washes. Beginning and experienced riders alike will enjoy this classic taste of the Old West.





1 SUNSCREEN: Sunscreen is a necessity no matter what time of year you visit! 2 WHISTLE: If you need assistance, the sound of a whistle carries farther than your voice. **3 WATER:** Carry more than you think you'll need for everyone in your party, including pets. Bring at least 1 quart per person for short hikes and at least 1 gallon per person for longer hikes. 4 TRAIL MAP: Maps of Scottsdale's McDowell Sonoran Preserve can be downloaded at scottsdaleaz.gov/preserve. 5 CELL PHONE: A fully charged cell phone is the best item to have in the event of an emergency. 6 SNACKS: Refuel with snacks like nuts, dried fruit, jerky or energy bars. 7 COMB: A fine-tooth comb comes in handy for flicking away cholla cactus segments that can attach to shoes, skin or clothes if you brush against them.



HIT THE TRAIL

To fully immerse yourself in the natural beauty and tranquility of the Sonoran Desert, head for Scottsdale's McDowell Sonoran Preserve. Eight trailheads conveniently dotted around the city provide access to the Preserve's 230+ miles of shared-use trails, which range from hard-surfaced, graded interpretive paths designed to be accessible for all to challenging mountain summit climbs that will get your adrenaline pumping.

POPULAR SCOTTSDALE-AREA HIKES

When you're ready to hit the trail, these popular hikes are a great place to start. Each provides easy access to the Sonoran Desert from developed trailheads with designated parking, restrooms, shade ramadas and, of course, magnificent views.



CAMINO CAMPANA INTERPRETIVE TRAIL

Fraesfield Trailhead (13400 E. Rio Verde Dr., Scottsdale) **Length:** 0.94 mi / 1.5 km (round trip) **Rating:** Easiest (ADA accessible) One of the Preserve's newest trails, Camino Campana provides 13 museumquality educational stops offering insights into how plants and wildlife interact and adapt to thrive in the desert.



GATEWAY-HORSESHOE LOOP

Gateway Trailhead (18333 N. Thompson Peak Pkwy., Scottsdale) Length: 1.7 mi / 2.7 km (loop) Rating: Easy

Three trails link to create this easy hike on a relatively flat path that crosses a desert bajada with trees, saguaro and other cacti, and desert shrubs. A wide variety of desert birds can be seen along this hike, which also provides majestic mountain views.



LOST DOG - RINGTAIL TRAIL LOOP

Lost Dog Wash Trailhead (12601 N. 124th St., Scottsdale) Length: 2.4 mi / 3.9 km (loop) Rating: Moderate

This two-trail hike is easy overall with a few moderate sections. Lost Dog Overlook has excellent views and is an ancient tool-making site. Spring wildflowers can be abundant along this trail from late February through April.



PINNACLE PEAK SUMMIT

Pinnacle Peak Park (26802 N. 102nd Way, Scottsdale) **Length:** 3.5 mi / 5.6 km (round trip) **Rating:** Moderate This wide, smooth trail switchbacks to the top of North Scottsdale's iconic

Pinnacle Peak, where you'll be rewarded with stunning city and Sonoran Desert views. Though the path is well-graded with few obstacles, the elevation gain earns this hike its moderate rating.



TOM'S THUMB - EAST END LOOP

Tom's Thumb Trailhead (23015 N. 128th St., Scottsdale) **Length:** 11.1 mi / 17.8 km **Rating:** Extremely Difficult

If you're a healthy, experienced hiker looking for a challenge, this trail is for you. In addition to its length, this trail provides rigorous challenges in the form of steep, loose sections and three major climbs (2,500-foot elevation gain overall). Your efforts will be rewarded with solitude,

stunning vistas, and ample plant and wildlife sightings.

5 surprises on scottsdale trails











hen the McDowell Sonoran Preserve was established in 1995, the intent was to protect a beautiful swath of desert and enhance the quality of life for Scottsdale residents and visitors alike. Mission accomplished. Within the 30,500+ acres sheltered by the Preserve, you'll find incredible scenery, a network of trails and more than a few surprises.

Number One BALANCED ROCK

Balanced Rock, located near Granite Mountain, always comforts me. It has absolutely no business being upright, yet there it stands, a multi-ton, mushroom-shaped boulder, precariously perched on a foundation of bare stone. Completely exposed and alone in the desert, it serves as a reminder that seemingly impossible things exist. They're all around if we just seek them out. Access via Granite Mountain Trailhead (31402 N. 136th St., Scottsdale)

Number Two CATHEDRAL ROCK METATES

Making the loop through the desert scrub surrounding Cholla Mountain, I stop to enjoy the ancient air-conditioning of Cathedral Rock, Just off the western flank of the mountain. mighty boulders are stacked together in a distinctive formation and pocked with shady grottoes. In the largest room, metates are still visible, the shallow indentations in the bedrock where Native Americans would grind food such as mesquite pods. Access via Brown's Ranch Trailhead (30301 N. Alma School Pkwy., Scottsdale)

Number Three DOUBLE-CRESTED SAGUARO

The saguaro is the unquestioned king of the Sonoran Desert, towering over the landscape. Yet despite their royal status, few wear a crown. Those that do are called crested saguaros. When the growing tip of a saguaro produces a fan-like shape instead of columnar arms, it's referred to as crested or cristate. Biologists aren't sure what causes the abnormal growth. The specimen standing at the junction of the Coyote Canyon and Desperado trails is one of the rarest. The main trunk forks, with both ends fanning out into a regal double crest. It's beautiful and eerily reminiscent of Princess Leia's twin-bun hairdo. *Access: Since Coyote Canyon is deep in the* Preserve, it can only be reached from connecting trails.

Number Four FACES OF COYOTE CANYON

The boulders give shape to narrow Coyote Canyon and also provide it with personality. This is a canyon full of whimsy. It's only a sliver of a defile, but erosional forces have added flavor, carving a variety of shapes and faces into the rough skin of the granite. I notice eyes peering at me, and worldweary grins. This, I decide, is where the Easter Island heads go to retire. Access: Since Coyote Canyon is deep in the Preserve, it can only be reached from connecting trails.

Number Five TALIESIN OVERLOOK

It's easy to lose yourself on Lost Dog Wash Trail. It slips immediately into the embrace of mountains, leaving all trace of the city behind. I ramble through desert flora, crossing washes and making a gentle climb. Just as I forget there's even a city nearby, I crest a ridge with a signed overlook. From this short path I savor views of not only the sprawling urban valley, but also Frank Lloyd Wright's Taliesin West, the famed architect's winter home and architectural laboratory. Access via Lost Dog Wash Trailhead (12601 N. 124th St., Scottsdale)







SCOTTSDALE

History on Hisplay

If you'd like to get a glimpse into Scottsdale's colorful past, this easy, self-guided stroll will introduce you to three historic Old Town landmarks and museums. The tour can be accomplished in about an hour and all admissions are free.



SCOTTSDALE HISTORICAL MUSEUM

Start your tour at the Little Red Schoolhouse near the western entrance to Scottsdale Civic Center, just east of Brown Ave.

The Little Red Schoolhouse was constructed in 1909 and over the years has served as a school, social hall and polling place, and housed the Scottsdale Chamber of Commerce prior to becoming the Scottsdale Historical

Museum. The museum chronicles the city's history through photos, artifacts and changing displays.

As you leave the museum, turn left and proceed to Brown Ave. Turn left again and your next stop, the Old Adobe Mission, is one block ahead on your left.



OLD ADOBE MISSION

Scottsdale's first Catholic church was constructed of handmade adobe bricks in 1933 and features beautiful Spanish Colonial Revival architecture and handcrafted stained-glass windows. Highlights inside include the Sacristy mosaic, historical photos and a statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

After touring the Mission, cross Brown Ave. and turn left. The Parada del Sol Rodeo Museum is just ahead on your right.



OLD TOWN SCOTTSDALE PARADA DEL SOL **RODEO MUSEUM**

Explore Scottsdale's rich rodeo history through artifacts like ropes, saddles, historical photos and original event posters. The museum, which is housed in the historic Noriega Livery building, also includes "The Stable," a large-scale mural by Joel Coplin that depicts horses being fed in their stalls.



GIDDY UP

Once you're decked out, it's time to put your digs to the test at MacDonald's Ranch. For over 50 years, this family-owned ranch has offered Scottsdale visitors an authentic Western experience. Book a group or private horseback ride on trails through the beautiful Sonoran Desert, and in the winter or spring, end the ride with a Cowboy Cookout. KICK IT UP

If you're ready to kick up those new cowboy boots, y'all must check out the Rusty Spur Saloon in Old Town Scottsdale. It was the first bar in the city and is a registered historical landmark. Once inside the swinging doors, order a cold one and wander through the bar checking out the walls boasting pictures, letters, dollar bills and license plates from its famous and not-so-famous past guests. With live music every day and night, lasso up your partner or gal pals and show off your twirls and two-steppin' skills. Make sure to keep your eyes peeled because country legends like Dierks Bentley and Blake Shelton have been known to grace the saloon.

RUSTY SPUR SALOON



Speaking of Dierks Bentley, if you're looking for a Western club with a rock-and-roll edge, head for the Old Town

Entertainment District. In addition to live music and dancing, Dierks Bentley's Whiskey Row serves up award-winning American gastropub cuisine and top-of-the-line drinks, ranging from handcrafted cocktails to wine, craft beer, champagne and, of course, whiskey.



HANDLEBAR J

Handlebar I debuted in the 1960s as Wild Bill's, North Scottsdale's original honky-tonk, and welcomed performers like Waylon Jennings. Since being purchased by the Herndon family and christened Handlebar J in 1975, this family-owned institution has become known for its lip-smacking BBQ and live music courtesy of local musicians and the Herndon Brothers band.




OLD TOWN'S **ARTISTIC** HUB

Entrances to most greens are accessible and forced carries are few.



2: TALKING STICK GOLF CLUB

While both the O'odham and Piipaash courses at this venue (located right behind Talking Stick Resort) are fairly straightforward designs by famed architects Bill Coore and Ben Crenshaw, it's the latter layout that may be better suited for those still learning the game. The greens aren't quite as crowned, and fewer angles come into play on the fairways.

3: PAPAGO GOLF COURSE

This beloved municipal course just west of Scottsdale has been welcoming golfers of all skill levels since 1963. The tree-lined fairways are pretty wide, water is only in play on two holes (the 1st and 11th) and you get some memorable views of the Papago Buttes looming right next to the course. Beginners are even invited to tour the facility and learn where everything is before stepping out onto the course!



4: TPC SCOTTSDALE CHAMPIONS COURSE

Its much higher-profile sibling, the TPC Stadium Course (home of the PGA Tour's WM Phoenix Open), is located right across the street, but the Champions is highly regarded by locals. And it's not just because the green fee is significantly lower; it's a fun, walkable layout with large greens, making it an easy golf course for beginners. The pace of play on the Champions Course also tends to be a bit better.

TOP PICKS FOR EXPERIENCED GOLFERS

So, you're ready for a challenge? Well then, the greater Scottsdale area is more than ready for you with its extensive menu of challenging layouts. Each requires your full concentration, strong shot-making skills, and perhaps a lucky bounce or two along the way to come in under par. Here are five courses that will quickly reveal just how good your game is.



1: TROON NORTH GOLF CLUB

The place that set the standard for upscale daily-fee golf when it debuted in 1990 retains its role as one of the best 36-hole facilities in the country. Both the Monument and Pinnacle courses are formidable, but the Monument recently underwent a renovation that included all new greens and new bunker sand.



2: GRAYHAWK GOLF CLUB

The Tom Fazio-designed Raptor Course hosted a PGA Tour event back in the late 2000s and it's still tough enough that breaking par from the tips is quite an accomplishment. Massive bunkers guard the large greens, where three-putts are not uncommon, and the closing par-5 remains one of the Valley's best.



3: WE-KO-PA GOLF CLUB

Bill Coore and Ben Crenshaw give you plenty of room off the tee on the Saguaro Course at We-Ko-Pa, but pick the wrong side of the massive fairways and you're in for a serious challenge to get your approach shots close to the hole, especially on elevated greens at the 8th, 14th and 16th holes.



4: TPC SCOTTSDALE STADIUM COURSE

Everybody wants to play where the pros play, and the world's best have been visiting the TPC Scottsdale's Stadium Course annually for the WM Phoenix Open since it opened in 1987. Normally the rough isn't quite as thick and the greens aren't quite as fast as during tournament week, but at just over 7,200 yards from the tips, the Stadium Course will give you all you can handle.

5: AK-CHIN SOUTHERN DUNES GOLF CLUB

Located just south of Scottsdale in nearby Maricopa, Ak-Chin Southern Dunes is just about as good as it gets. Plenty of length (7,546 yards from the tips), well-positioned bunkers and subtle yet tricky greens are all part of the challenge. Reward yourself for a good round with one of the clubhouse's killer milkshakes.



Scottsdale's dining scene is hotter than ever, with an array of exciting new restaurants debuting in the past year. From a local legend debuting a fresh concept to acclaimed chefs from across the country setting up shop, these five new hotspots showcase the diverse flavors that make Scottsdale a true foodie destination.



UCHI SCOTTSDALE

Uchi, the first Arizona outpost from James Beard Award-winning chef Tyson Cole's renowned Austin-based restaurant group, has opened in Old Town, and it's every bit as spectacular as you'd expect. Let the expert staff guide you through the menu or go all-in with a multicourse omakase for a surprise adventure. Uchi's greatest hits include hama chili (yellowtail with Thai chile and orange supreme), sake tom kha (salmon with coconut and lime leaf) and kinoko nigiri (brown butter-basted mushrooms), but also look out for daily specials like Wagyu striploin with maitake mushrooms and Hollandaise. And be sure to save room for dessert - they're just as stunning.

LA FOGATA KITCHEN & BAR

La Fogata Kitchen & Bar has arrived as part of The Scottsdale Resort & Spa's \$40 million makeover. The dining room, anchored by a wood-fired grill, and the patio overlooking the lush McCormick Ranch Golf Club greens set the stage for a menu melding modern Sonoran cuisine with global influences. Dive into standouts like meatballs bathed in mole and served with hand-pressed tortillas, scallops and grilled street corn topped with chimichurri and drizzled with cauliflower bisque, or Meat and Potatoes, an unassuming name for a dish that's a total indulgence, featuring gnocchi, braised oxtail, mushrooms and black truffle cheese.



LUNA BY GIADA

Luna by Giada has landed at the luxe Caesars Republic Scottsdale, and it's as chic as you'd expect from celebrity chef Giada De Laurentiis. Luna offers coastal Italian fare, pizzas and pastas in a sophisticated setting with her personal touches; for example, the LED pattern on the ceiling represents the positions of the constellations on the night her daughter was born. Standouts include Sicilian focaccia, carpaccio with bresaola (an Italian cured, air-dried beef) and her signature lemon spaghetti with mascarpone cheese. But you also don't want to miss the lemon pizza with garlic crème or pork and veal agnolotti in a parmesan broth, two exclusive dishes created by De Laurentiis for Scottsdale.



BEGINNER'S LUCK

Iconic Valley chef Bernie Kantak's latest addition to his restaurant group features a winning hand of family recipes and favorites from his other spots, including his famous Stetson Chopped Salad. Start your morning with shakshuka (baked eggs in a rich tomato sauce with local Noble Bread for dipping) or My Rich Uncle's French Toast with coconut-pecan streusel and butterscotch syrup. Or enjoy lunch and dinner savoring the Lucky Burger gilded with Grandma Francis' chili sauce or the 12-hour pork bowl, a delicious mélange of slow-roasted pork, blue corn grits, avocado, chicharrónes, queso fresco and more, which earned a double gold at the Devour food festival.

TELL YOUR FRIENDS

The Americano, already one of Scottsdale's hottest dining destinations, has upped the ante with an underground secret. Enter through a mirrored panel in a hallway and you'll descend the stairs to find Tell Your Friends, a swanky supper club where live music sets the mood and guests are dressed to impress. In addition to a stellar beverage program, you'll find a mouthwatering menu with specialties such as fire-roasted oysters topped with spinach and Chinese sausage, kimchi honey-glazed Korean fried chicken with smoked bacon ranch (and optional caviar!), and a splurge-worthy Steak Foie Poivre for two showcasing a 16oz. New York strip steak draped in a decadent green peppercorn and foie gras sauce.



Longtime Local Favorites

In addition to stellar new eateries, Scottsdale is home to many long-established local favorites. Here are six Scottsdale restaurants beloved by residents and visitors alike.



SUGAR BOWL

No trip to Old Town Scottsdale is complete without a stop at the Sugar Bowl Ice Cream Parlor & Restaurant. Established in 1958, the Sugar Bowl is a trip down memory lane with its pink décor and bustling soda fountain. Bring the whole family and enjoy classic diner eats and the best ice cream sundaes in town, including the Dusty Road Sundae and the Gosh-Awful-Gooey Banana Split. Original drawings from Family Circus cartoon creator and Sugar Bowl fan Bil Keane hang on the walls.

FNB

James Beard Award-winning chef Charleen Badman and frontof-the-house phenom Pavle Milic are the dynamic duo behind this Old Town gem. Badman's veggie-forward menu, crafted from locally sourced organic ingredients, changes regularly and also includes artisan meats and seafood, locally made pasta and decadent desserts. Pair your meal with a selection from Milic's hand-curated wine list, which includes a variety of Arizona wines including varietals from his own label, Los Milics. One visit and you'll see why FnB is a favorite restaurant among the locals.





EL CHORRO

In 1937, Jan and Mark Gruber transformed the buildings of a former girls' school into what is today El Chorro. Although the restaurant has changed hands and grown over the years, El Chorro retains its rustic elegance and reputation for outstanding cuisine. Positioned between Mummy and Camelback mountains, El Chorro specializes in classic fare from filet mignon to trout almondine but is most famous for its sugary sticky buns and breathtaking sunset views, which are best enjoyed from the spacious patio.

THE THUMB

At first glance, The Thumb appears to be a gas station. That's because, well, it is - but trust us on this one, you won't want to miss it. A North Scottsdale landmark for more than 12 years, The Thumb has been featured on Guy Fieri's popular "Diners, Drive-ins & Dives" for its robust menu of mouthwatering barbecue, including pulled pork, smoked sausage and the house specialty, St. Louis-style ribs. From breakfast options like Tom's Brisket Stack (hashbrown cakes, sliced brisket and over-easy eggs) to hearty two- or threemeat platters for lunch and dinner, you can't go wrong when you fill up at The Thumb.

THE MISSION

Chef and restaurateur Matt Carter has a serious taco habit - and we're glad he does. What began as a fondness for authentic Mexican street food evolved first into epic backyard pig roasts for Carter's friends and family, then eventually into his concept for The Mission, which boasts two Scottsdale locations at Old Town and Kierland Commons. Start with the 12-ingredient guacamole, then peruse Carter's robust menu of modern Latin cuisine that includes delights like spicy grilled street corn and Pork Shoulder Tacos with pineapple-habanero glaze.



Next up as we walk south on Marshall Way is Arizona Stronghold Vineyards, founded in 2007. A large photo mural on one wall transports you to their Willcox vineyard, while wine production images on the opposite wall provide behindthe-scenes insights into the wine-making process. Patio and indoor seating are available for individuals, groups and even corporate events.

Arizona Stronghold Vineyards' wines are the expression of the fierce and wild Arizona terroir. The brand is noted for its focus on Rhône and Italian varietals such as Syrah, Grenache, Cabernet Sauvignon, Malvasia Bianca and Viognier, as well as blends. Their award-winning wines, creative food menu and comfortable surroundings provide the perfect ambience for an afternoon or evening of relaxed socializing.

LOS MILICS VINEYARDS

A block south on Marshall Way is the newest tasting room on the Wine Trail, Los Milics Vineyards. Sleek and sophisticated, Los Milics invites you to cozy up to the bar or tables and enjoy a flight, glass or bottle of their small-production wines. You'll soon discover why Los Milics wines are nationally recognized.

Founded in 2018, the winery and vineyard are located in Elgin and are complemented by a state-of-the-art tasting room with a restaurant and casitas. Los Milics was voted one of the top three new winery experiences in the U.S. in 2023 by USA Today and voted No. 2 in the 10 Best Readers' Choice Awards in 2024, again by USA Today.

Los Milics specializes primarily in Spanish, French and Italian varietals. After tasting their wine, you may opt for a visit to their Elgin location; but for now, let's stay on the Wine Trail.

CARLSON CREEK VINEYARDS

Just across the street from Los Milics, you will find Carlson Creek's light and airy tasting room. It brings in a touch of the winery with the stave wall décor, copper bar and barrels. Winery and vineyard photos are displayed throughout, along with rotating fine art exhibits. There's a small semi-private nook for quiet conversations as well as a private room for events.

Currently one of the largest vineyards and wineries in the state, this gem was founded by the Carlson family in 2008 in the high desert of the Willcox Bench. In addition to the 13 varietals rotating on the menu, custom cheese boards are available. Carlson Creek specializes in wines produced from French, Italian and Spanish varietals.



The covered patio is pet-friendly.

The Wine Collective offers a number of special events such as Meet The Winemaker, Complimentary Tastings and the Sensory Wine Tasting Experience.

ARIDUS WINE COMPANY

One block south on East Main Street, Aridus Wine Company marks the end of the Wine Trail. The tasting room's rustic but sophisticated interior is made with natural and reclaimed materials, juxtaposed with lovely chandeliers. With ample room for groups in the main room, there's also a private tasting room for events.

Aridus Wine Company's Pearce, Arizona, vineyard was purchased in 2009 at the base of the Chiricahua Mountains. The Willcox winery opened in 2012. They

specialize in crafting premium wines from the unique terroirs of the region from single varietal and blends made from Spanish, French and Italian grapes. The name Aridus is a play on the word "arid," since we are, after all, in Arizona.

To make your wine-tasting experience complete, light fare and charcuterie boards are available.

5 BASIC STEPS OF WINE TASTING

SEE



You can tell a lot about a wine simply by its appearance. Typically, the darker the color, the more full-bodied the wine. **SWIRL**



A swirl aerates the wine and releases the aromatic components that make up the complexity of its flavor.

SNIFF



The wine's aroma (fruit, herb, flower aromas) and bouquet (spice, yeast, nut aromas) provide the first hint of its flavor profile.

SIP & SWISH



Let the wine dance over your taste buds to release its complex flavors so that all your senses can take them in.

SAVOR



Enjoy the wine's finish – the last flavors that linger on your palate after you swallow.





From swanky subterranean spots to luxe lounges, you won't want to keep these Scottsdale speakeasies a secret.

uring the Prohibition years, America went dry. The consumption of alcohol - including the production, sale and transportation of it - was illegal. But the party didn't stop. Instead, secret speakeasies and clandestine jazz clubs popped up in inconspicuous places. Revelers turned to these hooch hideaways in droves, ultimately turning drinking into a wild and rebellious act - and, consequently, a booming black market for booze.

By 1933, Prohibition was repealed, and getting together for drinks was legal again. Today, if you know where to look, you can find the same spirit of the Prohibition Era in Scottsdale, with just the right amount of speakeasy secrecy. Hidden entrances, craft cocktails, a hint of mystery - it's all here.



THE MADAM

Access to this Scottsdale speakeasy is disguised within The Scottsdale Resort & Spa's Social Boardroom, a casual bar and game room with a basementy-vibe complete with its own pool table and golf simulator. A decorative bookshelf doubles as a door to this elusive hush-hush space. But which one? That's

something for you to find out. Inside, The Madam is dressed up in shades of maroon, and amber candle vessels set the sultry scene. Elevated craft cocktails like the Devil's Gambit, garnished with dragon fruit, is an exotic indulgence exclusive to this Scottsdale speakeasy - and one you won't experience anywhere else.



TELL YOUR FRIENDS

Tell Your Friends is what Jay Gatsby's place might look like in this century: handsomely moody and decorated with gilded accents, oversized spinning disco balls, pops of neon lights, crimson velvet curtains. But this isn't West Egg, it's North Scottsdale. Hiding beneath The Americano restaurant, this sexy Scottsdale speakeasy is accessible via two flights of stairs and an online reservation. Live jazz tunes set the scene for signature cocktails, like the vodka-and-champagne-splashed Flapper Fizz or the peppery, pungent zero-proof Smooth Operator - best enjoyed between bites of fire-roasted East Coast oysters and decadent Italian-inspired desserts. For groups, go for the Punch Bowl, a gin-kissed, floral-forward boozy party punch of epic proportions designed to serve four to six people - it's the next best thing to a Gatsby party.



STRAIGHT UP

Straight Up is Scottsdale's undercover whiskey lounge at Hotel Adeline. The concealed cocktail bar has an easygoing atmosphere, indoor and outdoor accommodations suitable for both couples and small parties, and a menu of petite plates, ranging from blistered shishito peppers to glazed pork belly, that complements its libation lineup. Here, whiskey flights range from tasty tours of regions to customizable samplings - there's a flight for every type of whiskey aficionado at this Scottsdale speakeasy. Ask your bartender for a local spirit and you'll likely receive a dram of Whiskey Del Bac's award-winning American single malt: a mesquite-wood-smoked tipple with a flavor profile that can only be described as distinctly Arizona. In true speakeasy fashion, Straight Up is only accessible by way of a hidden entrance: an old-fashioned telephone booth.

Old Jown After Dark

When the sun goes down, every hour is happy hour in Old Town Scottsdale. More than 100 nightlife options – from sophisticated restaurants and wine bars to über-chic dance clubs - can be found nestled in Old Town's walkable neighborhoods. 

You'll find a bounty of natural wonders, quirky towns and historic landmarks throughout Arizona – most of which you can explore on an easy day or overnight trip from Scottsdale. Let's hit the road!



ROUTE 66

Drive Time: Varies by route We couldn't start an article about road trips without mentioning America's Mother Road, Route 66. A 158-mile swath of this legendary track spans northwestern Arizona and is studded with colorful Americana. Get your kicks with the burros in Oatman. Swing into the Sno-Cap Drivein for a burger, fries, Oreo milkshake and punny jokes from the servers. Grab a selfie standin' on the corner in Winslow. Arizona (ves. just like the song), Route 66 celebrates its centennial in 2026, so make plans now to join the fun!

TOMBSTONE

Drive Time (each way): 3 hrs., 10 min. Tombstone, "The Town Too Tough to Die," is home to the infamous O.K. Corral, where daily reenactments of the gunfight between the Earp brothers and the Clantons and McLaurys thrill visitors. Other Tombstone highlights include the Bird Cage Theatre, Boothill Graveyard and the Rose Tree Inn Museum. discovertombstone.com





MONUMENT VALLEY NAVAJO TRIBAL PARK

Drive Time (each way): 5 hrs., 20 min. SEDONA & JEROME


