Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport	In November 2021, Phoenix Sky Harbor debuted Terminal 3's new Escape Lounge with a wraparound bar and complimentary food and drink. The lounge is inside a glass-window enclosure and offers a variety of seating options to accommodate solo travelers and groups. In June 2022, Sky Harbor opened the Eighth Concourse in Terminal 4, which will be used by Southwest Airlines. The 275,000 square foot space features a variety of customer amenities, including access to charging stations in every seat, an Animal Relief Area, Family Restroom, Nursing Room, and hearing loop connectivity which will allow those with hearing devices to connect to the PA system. In the coming months, the concourse will feature new local shops and restaurants. Local favorites Pedal Haus Brewery and Sip Coffee & Beer will be in the new concourse. The retail shops will introduce not only national brands at the Uptown Phoenix shop and InMotion Entertainment, but also through a partnership, access to local products from Changing Hands Bookstores, Made Art Boutique and Melrose Pharmacy. The 2.5 mile extension connects the terminals with the Rental Car Center and adds two new stations – the Rental Car Center Station and the 24th Street Station. Scottsdale Airport	Scottsdale Airport received more than \$5.4 million in grants from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to improve the efficiency, safety and capacity at the airport. These grants will provide funding to construct an aircraft runup area, reconstruct a portion of the taxiway and taxiway connectors to current FAA safety standards, and rehabilitate a taxiway connector.  Jet Aviation opened a fixed-base operator facility at Scottsdale Airport in January 2021. Now Jet Aviation is expanding its footprint with two more projects. The first project will be leased to NetJets and includes a 30,000 square foot hangar and 12,000 square feet for offices and a customer terminal building. The first phase concentrated on paving of the ramp area and getting it ready as soon as possible to offer additional aircraft parking area. The second phase will include building the hangar and office space. The full project is anticipated to be completed by early 2024. Jet Aviation also is investing around \$6 million into building a new 18,000 square foot hangar that will provide much needed hangar space. Scottsdale Civic Center	Renovations to Scottsdale Civic Center began October 2021. The \$27.5 million in updates transformed the space into an event-ready venue. New amenities include two new stages, a small wedding lawn, a space for tents, a new botanical garden, an area for children and families, and new restrooms.
