The Parque	This billion-dollar development that will include apartments, restaurants, retail space and office buildings on the site of the abandoned CrackerJax amusement park. The Parque will sit on 32 acres that's right on the southern border of the Scottsdale Promenade. It will be made up of 12 buildings that range from one to 10 stories tall, or roughly 119 feet at the high end. The project plan shows that it will include: a 223-room five-star hotel on roughly 189,000 square feet of the property; five restaurants and over 25,000 square feet of retail space; a two-acre central park that would be public open space.
